MA Intercultural Anglophone Studies (MAIAS) is an innovative, researchoriented program in English and American Studies. It enables in-depth and theoretically informed study of the literatures and cultures of the English-speaking world, and of linguistic phenomena of English in its

varieties. A wide range of forms of cultural expression such as literature, film, theatre, music, and popular culture are addressed.

From various perspectives, this degree program

promotes the analysis of complex issues in culture, literature and language, including inter- and transcultural issues. The program is taught in English. The MAIAS program benefits from its integration with the research areas of American Studies, African Studies, and Anglo-German Studies, coordinated in interdisciplinary Research Centers on the Bayreuth Campus.

OCCUPATIONAL CAREERS

As the MAIAS program is directed toward advanced competences and skills, students are excellently prepared for careers and positions in the academic world, in business, or the increasingly important forums of cross-cultural exchange. In particular, they find attractive occupational pathways in research and teaching, media and journalism, publishing, new media, international cultural institutions, cultural management, intercultural consulting, service and trade.

DUAL DEGREE MA STUDIES WITH SHANGHAI

An innovative Dual Degree Program has been established by the University of Bayreuth and Shanghai International Studies University (SHISU). This Dual Degree Program is especially designed for students who seek responsible activities in intercultural cooperation, in communication-oriented fields of business, administration, politics, or academic life. MA students from Bayreuth have the option of spending their second year in this major Chinese city. The program, which is taught

in English, completes the focus of the Bayreuth curriculum with interculturally oriented courses as well as Chinese language. Students of SHISU, in



turn, are invited to join in their Shanghai second year the MA program at the University of Bayreuth, where the curriculum is continued by Anglophone studies in literature and culture or in linguistics (advanced); Colloquium on methods; Research seminar; MA Thesis. Each partner university – the University of Bayreuth and SHISU – will grant a Master's degree.
